

Yuan Ze University Regulations for Establishing Academic Credit Programs

1. The regulations established aim to provide a standard guideline when setting up academic credit programs in units. The course programs stated in the regulations are referred to the design and combination of cross department/school/college curriculum in all professional learning fields and are offered as an interdisciplinary field that combines courses from two or more degree programs or academic credit programs. Academic credit programs should invite an Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor, as the director of the academic credit programs, to be in charge of establishing academic credit programs, handling promotion activities and issuing certificate. For programs established by non-teaching units, a relevant committee shall be set up to review and deliberate program-related matters. The routine administrative operations of the program shall be handled by the unit that established the program.
2. The Academic Credit Programs of the school are divided into Normal Program and Micro-Program. For the Normal Program, the student shall select at least 12 credits, and for the Micro-Program shall select at least 8 credits. To establish the academic credit programs, the relevant regulations on matters—objectives, program title, curriculum plan, required subjects and credits thereof, director of academic credit programs, eligibility, student numbers, approval process, application deadline and certificates of academic credit programs and standard thereof must be established by each of the units and must be adopted by the Curriculum Committee Meeting and the Academic Affairs Meeting for ratification and implementation before announcement, as shall amendments when they are made.

Yuan Ze University Industry-Academia Programs are divided into "Enterprise Programs" and "Industry Programs". The names, content, and implementation methods of these programs are conducted in accordance with the regulations stipulated in the "Yuan Ze University Regulations for the Establishment of Industry-Academia Programs".

3. The minimum credits required for graduation will not be increased due to studying academic credit programs. Moreover, students cannot apply for extending study period due to studying academic credit programs except as provided in other regulations.
4. Students who intend to study the academic credit programs should meet all required conditions, register online for studying academic credit programs in the application

period and receive the approval of the application from academic units in charge of academic credit programs. Then, students can select courses of academic credit programs online.

5. In order to obtain the certificates of the academic credit programs, students who complete all required subjects and receive all credits for those courses can file an application with their official transcripts enclosed to colleges at which the academic credit programs are offered or the establishing unit and receive the approval of the application afterwards.
6. All applications for academic credit programs must be filed online. The format for the certificate of academic credit programs is designed and set up by Academic Affairs Office except as provided in other regulations.

7. If the academic credit programs cannot be offered due to the change of educational objectives, the transition of industrial development or other factors, the units in charge of these programs can alter the programs' contents or cancel the programs based on the original approved procedures.

If the number of students enrolled in the academic credit programs is less than 10 in a consecutive of 3 academic years, the Office of Academic Affairs can call a meeting to reevaluate the establishment of these programs. The programs can be called off after the re-evaluation being approved by the Curriculum Committee Meeting and passed at the Academic Affairs Meeting afterwards.

8. In order to cooperate with the Ministry of Education to promote the "Taiwan Artificial Intelligence College Alliance" (TAICA) plan, the establishment of the alliance's AI course, number of credits. Regulations and application procedures shall be governed by the relevant regulations; the university shall establish an "Artificial Intelligence Academic Credit Program Committee" in accordance therewith and carry out the related administrative work.

Students who fulfill the requirements of the university's academic credit programs shall be awarded an Academic Credit Program Certificate by the university. Those who additionally satisfy the alliance requirements shall be issued an Academic Credit Program Certificate by the alliance.

9. These regulations will be adopted by the Academic Affairs Meeting before implementation, as shall amendments when they are made.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version
