Why should you join the project?

Constantly changing global business environment is a challenge that all the entrepreneurs must face.

Virtual cooperation in international teams is a great opportunity to experience global business in real life.



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The main learning goal of the virtual exchange:

Enhanced awareness of the problems of social entrepreneurship.

This will include your ability:

- to identify social issues and challenges for an ethical entrepreneurial culture,
- to understand the importance of Sustainable Development Goals,
- to compare and contrast the examples of social entrepreneurship in Peru and in Poland,
- to identify and define entrepreneurial opportunities, and
- to present an entrepreneurial opportunity to a range of audiences.

How this project will help you to improve your skills?

- **Enhanced language skills**, this will be reflected in your ability to speak **English** during conference sessions and by your ability to write messages in English to your project partner/s.
- **Enhanced ICT literacy** that will be reflected in your ability to post content, images, videos and different files on the Padlet virtual wall. This also will be reflected in communicating and sharing different forms of files through social media groups (ex. Facebook) or online applications (WhatsApp, Slack) of your choice.
- **Enhanced teamwork skills** that will be reflected in your ability to work on a cross-cultural project: sharing task, coordinating efforts with your project partner/s, cooperating, helping each other and respecting the deadlines.
- **Increased self confidence** that will be reflected in your ability to communicate in an intercultural environment and to make friends with foreign students.

Project schedule

- Project will last from From October 20th h - Nov 20st, 2026
 - Part 1 (Thursday Oct 20th) a kick-off meeting and self introductions: Oct 20th (GMT-5) 12:00 pm Lima Time/ GMT+2) 19:00 Krakow (Synchronous session)
 - Part 2 (Oct 26th- 30th): team icebreaking task (teams of 4-5 students) and Sustainable Development Goals (discussion about the SDG and the selection of one of them)
 - Part 3 (Nov 2nd to 6th): social entrepreneurship – the comparison between companies in the participants Countries exploring the opportunities and designing own idea for „a SDG start-up”
 - Part 4 (Nov 9-13th): presenting own idea for „a SDG start-up” (videos)
 - Part 5 (Nov 16-20th) : a wrap-up meeting and students’ presentations (Synchronous session

Two compulsory plenary sessions are planned throughout the project: a kick-off and a wrap-up meeting.

You decide on your team schedule together with your teammates (there is no fixed timetable!)

- Student workload: around 2 – 3 hours per week
